

# Women's International Network of Utility Professionals (WiNUP) Nashville Chapter

### Scholarship Application 2023 – 2024 Academic Year

The Women's International Network of Utility Professionals is an organization providing a link for developing and recognizing professionals involved with utility business trends, issues, products, and services.

**Scholarship Vision:** One **\$1,000 scholarship** awarded annually to encourage and assist qualified students to pursue a college education in STEM fields and positively influence the utility profession upon graduation.

**Terms:** Awarded for academic year 2023 – 2024. The scholarship must be used during the academic year when the check is issued. Any excess must be returned to the WiNUP Nashville Chapter.

**<u>Eligibility Requirements</u>**: All current high school seniors planning to enter the 2023 – 2024 school year who meet the following requirements:

- Female candidates only.
- Must be a resident of the State of Tennessee.
- Must have a minimum grade point average of a 3.0,
- Must provide proof of acceptance by an ABET accredited college or university pursuing a degree in a STEM-related field of study.

## Selection Criteria to be considered by WiNUP scholarship committee:

- High School transcript with grade point average.
- Recommendation form (see attachment) by a current teacher, or guidance counselor, who is familiar with your academic achievement and leadership skills.
- Required major in engineering, architecture, mathematics, computer science or related field.
- Evidence of serious scholastic attitude, good character, leadership qualities, and well-rounded personal development.
- Preference for the scholarship will be given to students planning to work in the power industry after graduation.

### 2023 Schedule:

February 1 – April 15: Applications accepted (postmarked no later than April 15<sup>th</sup>).
May 1<sup>st:</sup> Notification of awards to scholarship recipients.
May-June: Distribution of scholarship funds (directly to college or university).

### Application:
