- 2. Student Essay (include achievements, honors/awards, career interests, and the reason you deserve the scholarship (not to exceed one typed page, double-spaced)
- 3. Recent Photo
- **4.** Official High School Academic Transcript (with school seal or stamped official transcript)
- 5. Official ACT/SAT Score Sheet
- 6. Letter of Recommendation from a community leader
- 7. Letter of Recommendation from a school official/teacher
